

Mark and his three adult children (who also reside in Bucks County) are regularly seen supporting programs and businesses in the community. They share regular traditions like outings to our Annual Grange Fair and Southampton Days Festival. It would not be unusual to see the Miller family on either side of the table, on the stage or in the audience, cooking or serving the food, or simply enjoying being guests for the evening.

All three of our Bucks County Commissioners have worked with Mark in varying capacities. He was in contact with my office during the land development process for five Centennial SD construction projects. Commissioner Robert Loughery spoke recently at a Career and Technical Education event organized by Mr. Miller, and Mr. Miller spoke last year at an event hosted by Commissioner Diane Marseglia.

As a longtime resident and graduate of the Centennial School District, where my father served on the school board for almost 25 years, I deeply appreciate the efforts Mark has made on behalf of our residents. I have no doubt that Mark will prove to be a valuable asset and leader to the Pennsylvania School Boards Association, just as many other of Bucks County's finest have served the Commonwealth at all levels over the years.
