Davis: Town Hall forum set on property taxes, H.B. 76

HARRISBURG, Sept. 6 – State Rep. Tina Davis, D-Bucks, will serve as host of a public Town Hall discussion on property taxes and legislation designed to eliminate them from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 12, at King’s Caterers, 4010 New Falls Road, Bristol.

“The groundswell to enact House Bill 76, the Property Tax Independence Act, is growing, and we’ll analyze all of the ramifications of the legislation,” Davis said. “We need a fairer way to pay for public education, and the bill is designed to eliminate property taxes in two years.”

Davis said the forum will feature David Baldinger of the Pennsylvania Taxpayers Cyber Coalition, a taxpayer advocacy group, and Mark B. Miller, vice president of the Pennsylvania School Boards Association and a board member of the Network for Public Education.

“We need to secure quality education for our children AND keep people in their homes,” Davis said. “I have seen firsthand the devastating effects of property taxes not only on homeowners, but also on families wanting to buy a home, and I urge all interested constituents to attend the session and provide input on this hot-button topic.”
